WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

Every person who (a) is the full age of **eighteen years** on election day (18th October); (b) is a **Canadian citizen** on election day; and (c) has been ordinarily residing in the Municipality of Victoria County for **period of three months** prior to election day, and continues to so reside.

Residents of the Municipality of Victoria County, otherwise qualified to vote, but not on the final list of voters, may vote on **Saturday, 18th October** by presenting evidence of identification and residency to the Deputy Returning Officer in his or her polling district, and by swearing to and signing an oath of affirmation.
